Award-Winning Programs:

The Iowa Arts Festival is regularly recognized as the Best Festival in the area through the Iowa City Press-Citizen and Locals Love Us, with the Iowa City Jazz Festival receiving recognition as One of the Best. For the last two years the Iowa Arts Festival has been recognized as the Best Festival through Little Village's Best of CRANDIC. Summer of the Arts programming has also received awards through the Iowa Cultural Corridor Alliance and International Festival and Events Association.

Iowa Arts Festival:

The lowa Arts Festival has been lowa City's unofficial kickoff to summer since 1983. Covering nine downtown city blocks, it includes a juried fine art show with approximately 115 artists from around the country, an Emerging Student Artist Pavilion, a Main Stage which features a combination of local and national performers such as Los Lobos, Steve Earl, and the Indigo Girls, a local side stage, a children's area with a family stage, a local Carnival Parade, and with food and beverage vendors.

Iowa City Jazz Festival:

The lowa City Jazz Festival was founded in 1991 to feature jazz music and make it accessible to the public. The festival includes a Main Stage, three side stages (College, Local and Youth), a small artist row and food and beverage vendors. The Jazz Festival has been recognized as one of the top ten jazz festivals in the country through Downbeat Magazine and has a history of bringing in high quality established jazz musicians like Donny McCaslin and Poncho Sanchez as well as up-and-coming jazz musicians.

Friday Night Concert Series:

The Friday Night Concert Series runs weekly from mid-May through August and has been bringing the community together since 1993. Attendees enjoy live music from a wide range of genres performed by some of the best musicians in Eastern Iowa. This is the event that really brings out the Iowa City community from all walks of life to dance and enjoy their favorite bands.

Free Movie Series:

The Free Movie Series started as a pilot program in 2005 and was added to Summer of the Arts when the organization was formed later that year. We show 9-11 movies on the University of Iowa campus outside of Macbride Hall weekly from June—August. All movies are rated PG-13 or lower so the movie can be enjoyed by everyone. The series features a combination of recent hits as well as classics from drama to comedy, musicals and animated feature films.

Soul & Blues Festival:

lowa Soul Festival started in 2013, and in 2019 the name was changed to the Soul & Blues Festival as the focus shifted to celebrating the Black experience through the local and global reach of Soul & Blues music. This two day festival also includes a Black Author's Panel, food and beverage vendors and children's activities.

Holiday Thieves Market:

Summer of the Arts stepped up in 2019 and began producing the Holiday Thieves Market when the University of Iowa announced the cancellation of Fine Arts Council and thus the discontinuation of the event's 50 year tradition. This holiday fine art show features approximately 110 fine artists from around the Midwest and provide a great opportunity for holiday shopping in early December.
